- Whether the instructions explain the proper modeling steps
 - The instructions explain the steps well enough. The fact that I was able to understand what to do with no prior knowledge shows a lot.
- Whether the measurements are explained well
 - The measurements are explained well enough. However, some of the shapes' names are names that
 I've never heard of before, such as 'truncated right cone.'
- If the instructions were clear enough for you to model the chess set in one go. If not, how many tries did it take.
 - I reset the program about 4 times because I messed up on some of the commands. I'm not entirely sure if it was my fault or if it was the direction's fault.
- Where did you get stuck in the steps?
 - When opening a database for the pawn, the directions say to type '\$opendb pawn.g,' and I was stuck
 on this step for a while because the \$ in the beginning shouldn't be typed.
- Which command did you find hard to understand and needs more explanation?
 - The command that I found the hardest was probably something about the raytracing.
